# The Future Energy Jobs Act



FEJA passed the Illinois General Assembly with bipartisan support in 2016. The new law generates \$12-\$15 billion in new private investments in Illinois for renewable energy, like wind and solar.

# The Future Energy Jobs Act



## Solar and Wind incentives

- Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) Goal of 25% Renewable Energy by 2025
- Expands incentives for rooftop solar and utility scale solar
- Creates Community Solar and Solar for All Programs



## Energy Efficiency

- Lower electric bills, save \$, create JOBS!



## Workforce Development

- Solar Training Pipeline, Craft Apprenticeship, and Multi-cultural Jobs Program

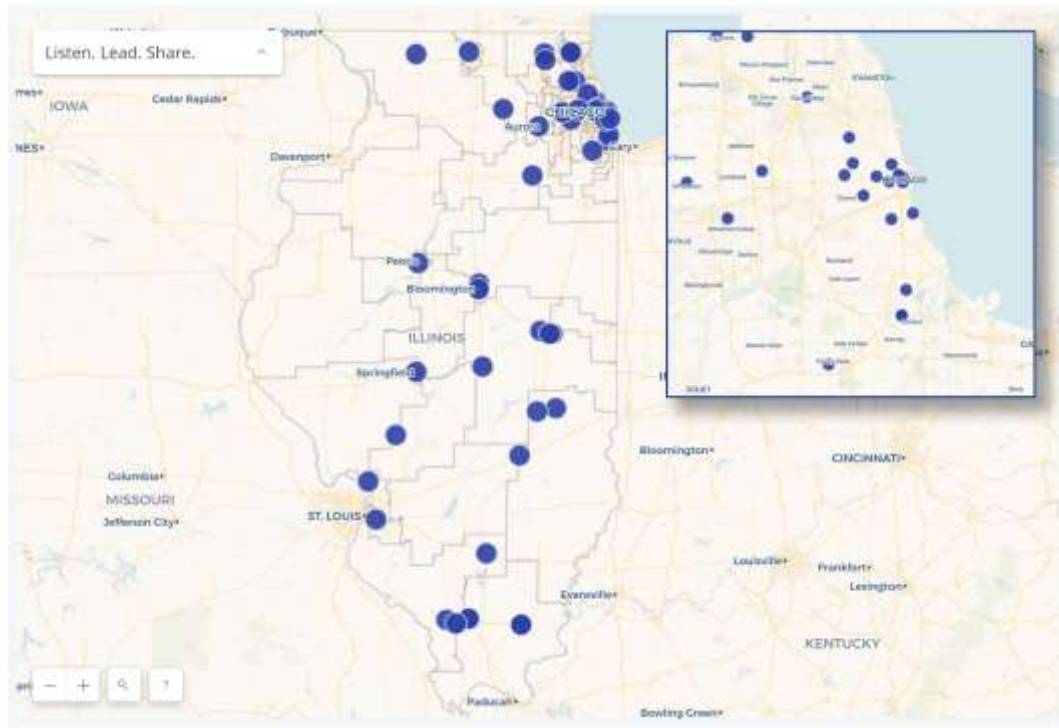

## The Four Policy Pillars:

3. Increase electric vehicles

**A Just Transition.** Provide support for communities and workers impacted by closures or reduced utilization of coal by:

- *Create Clean Energy Empowerment Zones*
